## Newsletter – October

### Rissington – Round 7 of the 210 Challenge

As is usual for this time of year there was no Saturday practice, which left the pits very empty until early Sunday morning. Mark Henry joined us as a guest driver for this meeting, it was fantastic to see him out there!

#### Heat 1

To throw M. Henry in at the deep end for his first race in a kart in over 6 years he started on pole. D. Bury made a fantastic start and by the time he was along the back straight he was in the lead with Woodward 2<sup>nd</sup> and Callaghan 3<sup>rd</sup>. They remained in this order until lap 8 when Woodward went off on to the grass at the top corner. He managed to keep it running and get back on the track to take the flag, but sadly much further down the field. On inspection after the race a broken seat stay was found to be the culprit. On the same lap the race long battle between Green and Whyte came to a head with Whyte managing to overtake putting him in to 3<sup>rd</sup>. Fowler and T. Bury had a close race, swapping positions a couple of times throughout the race and seeming to take the line together.

#### Heat 2

On the lights Whyte shot straight through the centre of the field flying in to 2<sup>nd</sup>, with D. Bury in the lead. Fowler, Callaghan and Woodward were all in the running for 3<sup>rd</sup> with Callaghan overtaking Fowler on lap 6 to take the position. Fowler and Woodward had a coming together on lap 9 causing Woodward to retire, leaving Fowler in 4<sup>th</sup>. Further back in the field there was some very close racing between Watkins in 7<sup>th</sup>, Masson in 8<sup>th</sup> and S. Henry in 9<sup>th</sup>.

#### Heat 3

On the change of the lights D. Bury stormed off in to the lead followed by T. Bury, Watkins and Whyte. At the end of the first lap T. Bury was fighting off Woodward for 3<sup>rd</sup> with Watkins and Fowler not far behind. Callaghan meticulously worked his way through the field passing Fowler on lap 7 to get in to 4<sup>th</sup> behind T. Bury. Fighting all the way to the flag

Callaghan nearly took T. Bury on the line, but not quite!

#### Final

D. Bury had a good start from the front row followed by T. Bury and Callaghan. By the end of the lap 1 D. Bury was pulling away from the rest of the field with a gap forming between him and Whyte in second. This wasn't to last, over the race Whyte caught D. Bury and on lap 8 was right behind hassling for the lead. Behind the leaders, T. Bury, Callaghan and Woodward were all in the running for 3<sup>rd</sup>. Woodward got past Callaghan on lap 3, T. Bury seeming to have a problem and dropping back a couple of places. Fowler then got in to the mix, catching up to the back of Callaghan. On lap 8 Woodward was noticeably pulling away from the rest of the field and Whyte finally managed to overtake D. Bury to put himself in the lead.
