### **Newsletter – August**

## Rissington – Round 5 of the 210 Challenge and Round 2 of the Supa 60's

Kate will be around this weekend with the information for the presentation evening, there is a slight change to room bookings so please make sure to read the information Kate hands out. As is traditional there will be a meeting at the Midland Champs on the Saturday night for an update on Challenge business.

#### Heat 1

Both the Bury's and W. Cox made fantastic starts barrelling through the field to put D. Bury in 2<sup>nd</sup> and T. Bury in 3<sup>rd</sup> with Perkins in the lead. In the next two laps T. Bury fought his way in to the lead, first overtaking D. Bury and then Perkins. He held on to this lead for the rest of the race. By lap 5, the top 6 were in position and held that for the rest of the race. Hancock battled his way through the field to the point where he was on the bumper of Green, but on the final lap some 210 Gremlins appeared forcing him to drop to 10th. As a little side story, Fowler was black flagged for only wearing one glove. Where was the other you might ask, well it was taking the place of his fuel filler cap which had come off on the out lap (causing him to slow, lose his starting position and start from the back of the grid.) 1st T. Bury, 2nd Whyte, 3rd D. Bury, 4th Woodward, 5th Perkins, 6th Green.

#### Heat 2

The field was held at the lights for a long time, when the lights finally changed a number of drivers were taken by surprise, with a few getting some love taps from behind! Hopes took the lead from the start, holding off D. Bury in 2<sup>nd</sup>, Woodward in 3<sup>rd</sup> and Whyte in 4<sup>th</sup> with some impressive defensive driving. Lap 6 saw some fierce racing with Whyte and Woodward overtaking D. Bury to push him back to 4<sup>th</sup> place, putting Woodward in 3<sup>rd</sup> and Whyte in 2<sup>nd</sup>. Two laps from the flag, Whyte managed to sneak past Hopes with Woodward (what I can only describe as) scooching past him not long before the line. 1<sup>st</sup> Whyte, 2<sup>nd</sup> Woodward, 3<sup>rd</sup> Hopes, 4<sup>th</sup> D. Bury,

5<sup>th</sup> Green, 6<sup>th</sup> Fowler.

#### Heat 3

T. Bury had a fantastic start forming a big gap between him and Hopes in 2<sup>nd</sup>, who was closely followed by W. Cox, Perkins and D. Bury, who also had great starts coming from the back rows of the grid. Unfortunately a spin on the first corner on lap 3 saw T. Bury shuffle

back to 5<sup>th</sup> place. The first 7 karts were now all very close and the racing was intense with D. Bury, Whyte, Hopes, W. Cox, Perkins, Woodward and Henry all within spitting distance of each other. On lap 4 Whyte streaked past D. Bury along the back straight and started to pull away, building a gap between them. D. Bury responded by pulling away from the 5 behind. On lap 7, a number of drivers all piled in to the first corner together only to realise there wasn't quite enough room for all of them on the track. Hopes spun, but managed to keep it going, but T. Bury ended up on the grass.

#### Final

Front row: Whyte, D. Bury, Woodward with T. Bury and Hopes on the 2<sup>nd</sup> row. D. Bury managed to get out in front on the first lap with Woodward in 2<sup>nd</sup>, and Whyte in 3<sup>rd</sup> followed by Fowler and T. Bury. Whyte overtook Woodward on lap 3 and then starting hunting down D. Bury, managing to catch and overtake him on lap 6. Towards the end of lap 3 Henry and Hopes came in the pits bend side by side ending up doing some grass cutting allowing Green to overtake both at once. Fowler and T. Bury were fighting hard for 4<sup>th</sup>. On the last lap Woodward had a problem and slowed right down along the back straight promoting T. Bury in to 3<sup>rd</sup> and Fowler in to 4<sup>th</sup>.1<sup>st</sup> Whyte, 2<sup>nd</sup> D. Bury, 3<sup>rd</sup> T. Bury, 4<sup>th</sup> Fowler, 5<sup>th</sup> Green, 6<sup>th</sup> Perkins, 7<sup>th</sup> Hancock and 8<sup>th</sup> Henry.
