Newsletter – October Final Round Shenington

A fantastic line up for the final round of the 2017 210 challenge which is always good to see, but where on earth did that year go! We would be in for an exciting days racing although somewhat gruelling for the poor engine with three 11 lap heats and a 13 lap final.

Heat 1

Plain joined us once again to swell the ranks and took the lead which he valiantly held onto until the chequered flag. D. Bury and Fowler had a good dice on lap 2 for 2nd place with Fowler eventually taking up 2nd position on lap 4. By lap 6 Plain had put some distance between himself and Fowler, who was being very closely followed by D. Bury 3rd, Perkins 4th, Whyte 5th, and Woodward 6th .Lap 7 saw Whyte pass Perkins for 4th. Fowler had moved away from the gaggle behind of D. Bury, Whyte, Perkins and Woodward, 3rd place could be anyones! Two laps later and Whyte had passed D. Bury to claim 3rd. On the last lap Woodward managed to pass Perkins out of Stratford and with a photo finish passed D.Bury on the line by 0.00.35.

Heat 2

Fowler made the best start from D. Bury, W. Cox, Green, Whyte and Perkins. D. Bury had a glimpse of the lead during the first lap but Fowler soon snatched it back. By lap 3 Plain had appeared in 3rd then on the next two laps he picked off D. Bury and Fowler to claim the lead. This unfortunately was short lived as he pulled off with noise issues on lap 7 forcing him to hand the lead back to Fowler. D. Bury was now up to 2nd, Whyte 3rd, Green 4th, W. Cox 5th and Woodward 6th. Woodward pulled off a lap later promoting Perkins to 6th.

Heat 3

Henry led the pack around cafe for the first lap followed by W. Cox, D. Bury, Fowler, Hancock and Woodward. On the next lap both D. Bury and Fowler had passed Henry and W. Cox to take 1st and 2nd respectively. By lap 3 the top 6 had a complete change Fowler now led with Plain 2nd, D. Bury 3rd, Woodward 4th Hancock 5th and Whyte 6th. Lap 5 saw Plain take the lead and a few laps later Green was up to 4th having passed Hancock and Whyte. Whyte then followed through to take Hancock. For the remainder of the race D. Bury tried very hard to pass Fowler to claim 2nd but to no avail.

Final

With the front row of Fowler, Whyte and D. It was Plain who pulled away first with D. Bury, Fowler, Whyte, Henry, W. Cox and the rest. Whyte passed Fowler through Pits Bend on lap 2.By midrace distance Plain had a comfortable lead with D. Bury and Whyte dicing for 2nd, behind them were two sets of three drivers Fowler, Perkins and Green were dicing for 4th whilst Hancock, Woodward and W. Cox were dicing for 7th. By lap 9 Whyte had passed D. Bury to claim 2nd in the race but he knew he was in 1st position for championship points. Perkins unfortunately had to pull off promoting Green to 5th (who would succumb to mechanical gremlins and slow) and Woodward 6th.
