Rissington June 6th – ROUND 1 – '0' plate

The weather for the weekend was glorious which would certainly catch a few out. I wonder how many woke up Monday morning with a red and white face denoting where the mask had been!!!

7 mins plus a lap for three heats and 9 mins plus a lap for the final was the order of the day.

Heats

Father and son Lionel and Aaron Sifleet dominated the first heat in 1st and 2nd until what was supposed to be the last lap, (lap 12) Rob Perkins who'd been making inroads on A. Sifleet gained 2nd place. With the absence of the checkered flag another lap had to be completed. Top 6 - 1st L. Sifleet, 2nd R. Perkins, 3rd A. Sifleet, 4th Tom Whyte, 5th Paul Fowler, 6th Neil Hancock.

Heat 2 saw the grid form up a lot further up the start Straight (apparently the drivers couldn't see the lights because of the sun) The deliberate mistake was that the front row were now underneath the lights!!! On the second attempt they were moved a little further back but confusion set in when the grid markings were 2 by 2, so round again they went. Third time lucky they say and it was A. Sifleet that made the best start, by lap 2 Dan Bury had peaked too early claimed 2nd then came in for a quick pit stop and rejoined a lap down. Lap 4 saw L. Sifleet snatch the lead from his son A. Sifleet along the Back Straight to only hold onto it for a lap when he was seen to leave the track at the end of the Start Straight with only 3 wheels securely fixed to his wagon! On the same lap Perkins took advantage of a slight stutter from A. Sifleet to claim the lead. A. Sifleet not having any of it retook the place back 4 laps later and went onto take the win from Perkins by only 0.15, Tony Bury having fended off a charging N. Hancock finished 3rd. Top 6 – 1st A. Sifleet, 2nd Perkins, 3rd T. Bury, 4th Hancock, 5th Whyte, 6th Russell Hopes. D. Bury had a glimpse at the lead for heat 3 until Perkins took over at the front. These two put a huge distance between themselves and the rest of the pack. Try as he might D. Bury would not be able to catch and pass Perkins. There was a coming together by a few on lap 7 which unfortunately lost T. Bury his well-earned 3rd position. Top 6 – 1st Perkins, 2nd D. Bury, 3rd Whyte, 4th Hancock, 5th Hopes, 6th T. Bury.

The Final

The front row for the final was hosted by pole -Perkins, A. Sifleet and Whyte. With that coveted '0' plate and trophy in the sights of many, it was Whyte who make the best start, Perkins having the inside line position managed to squeeze passed at the first corner to lead the pack. By lap 2 L. Sifleet had made it up to 2nd and demoted Perkins at the end of the Back Straight. A. Sifleet was in 3rd with D. Bury hot on his heels, Whyte 5th, T. Bury 6th. D. Bury was up to 3rd on lap 4 and in 2nd by lap 9 as Perkins had succumbed to a barrel stud failing and was out of the running. By lap 10 L. Sifleet still led with D. Bury trying his best to reel him in, A. Sifleet 3rd, Whyte was 4th T. Bury 5th, Stuart Henry 6th. On the following lap A. Sifleet began to slip down the field with a loose bubble shield thus promoting everyone up one place with Hopes now in 6th place. The order of the field remained the same until the flag.

L. Sifleet came in victorious, D. Bury 2nd, Whyte 3rd, T. Bury 4th, S. Henry 5th and R. Hopes completing the top 6.
